TASTING NOTES

A light fresh blend of the classic white grapes of this region of Portugal – Arinto, Fernao Pires – with a little Sauvignon Blanc for extra freshness. This is made with free-run juice and is a great example of the exciting new wines coming out of Portugal.

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EL COTO CRIANZA 2011 RIOJA SPAIN

TASTING NOTES

One of the top selling Rioja in the world this is made from low-yielding Tempranillo grapes and carefully crafted to taste both modern and traditional. Flavours of cherry, spice and vanilla jump out of the glass and are followed by cocoa and cherry pie flavours and balanced fruity freshness.

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Classic Rioja – a blend of Tempranillo (75%), Garnacha (10%) and Mazuelo (15%) and aged for 16 months in American and French Oak Casks. Aromas of vanilla and spice, full flavoured and complex.

This unoaked Chardonnay is matured on its lees (spent yeast cells) and stirred regularly for an extended period to intensify its flavours and bring out the soul of this complex fruit driven wine.

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MONTES CLASSIC SERIES COLCHAGUA MERLOT 2013 COLCHAGUA CHILE

TASTING NOTES

The Colchagua Valley is perfect for red wine making with warm days, cool nights and moderating breezes from the ocean. Intense aromas of red fruits, plums and toasted cedar - juicy, rounded and complex with fine lingering fruits.

A sublime dry Riesling produced from the high Eden Valley in the Barossa Ranges and bottled Koonunga Hill first came to fame. Floral, steely and fresh with lovely green-apple acidity and lingering tart fruits.

TASTING NOTES

Chester Osbourne is one of the great personalities of the wine world but never underestimate just how good a winemaker he is – D'Arrys Original is a true New World Icon wine. A blend of Shiraz and Grenache with complex sweet and savoury flavours – plums, liquorice, nutmeg and a hint of cedar.

TASTING NOTES

From the Navarra region to the east of Rioja and produced from fine old Garnacha vines. Intense strawberry and red fruit aromas, lively acidity and beautifully textured fruit flavours.

LA MARCA PROSECCO SPUMANTE NV TREVISO ITALY

TASTING NOTES

There is a reason we drink so much Prosecco in Ireland and this wine encapsulates it perfectly. Fine persistent bubbles, aromas of citrus, honey and white floral notes which give way to fresh flavours of ripe citrus, green apple and grapefruit. Great on its own or with fragrant and spicy dishes.

TASTING NOTES

Packed with exuberant charm Piper-Heidsieck NV positively bursts with citrus and orange juiciness on a wave of grilled toast and marzipan and finishes with crisp toasted almond flavours and light citrus. There is a reason Champagne is the world's favourite sparkling wine.
